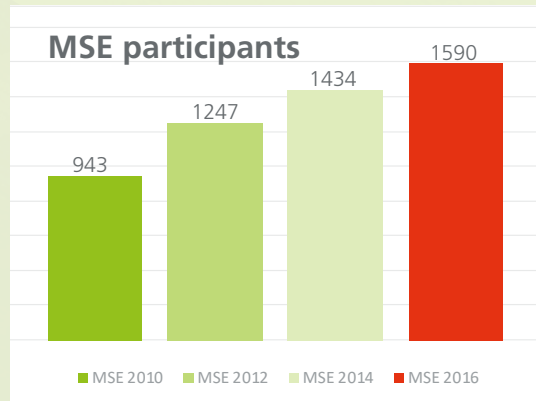


GENERAL INFORMATION
